Parents can create accounts for their children. In Beanstack, you can view the available activities, log the minutes you have read, write book reviews, and more.

Any kind of reading counts! Magazines, comic books, picture books, eBooks, audiobooks — if you read or listened to it, it counts! You'll earn raffle tickets as you read and do activities. The more tickets you get, the better your chance to win! You can also trackyour reading through the Beanstack app, Beanstack Tracker.
